SUNDAY ONLY Leg Match: ISRPA Members: Adults \$30.00, Juniors \$10; Non Members \$40.00, Juniors \$20 *includes \$10 CMP fee

ENTRIES:

Preregistration is Stongly Suggested but not Required. Range Capacity is 60 competitors.** Sign up on line on the ISRPA website: www.isrpa.org. Match fees can be paid on line prior to the match, or by check or cash on site. *Preregistration includes instruction for Military Base Security.**

ELIGIBILITY:

Membership in the National Rifle Association is strongly encouraged but not required. Membership in the ISRPA (Indiana State Rifle and Pistol Association) or the State Association of the State in which the competitor resides is strongly encouraged and includes discount for membership. Membership in ISRPA may be executed on line in advance or on the day of the match. Full Time Students residing in Indiana may participate as a resident in EITHER their home state or Indiana State Championships, but not both.

RULES:

NRA rules apply for all NRA Registered matches. Competitors should make themselves familiar with these rules. NRA Highpower Rifle Rulebooks will be for sale when available.

CMP rules will apply for CMP sanctioned matches.

CLASSIFICATION:

The NRA Classification system will be used for NRA matches. Anyone who does not have a Highpower classification will fire in the Master Class (Master Unclassified) for one match only. A temporary score book will be maintained and future entries based on scores fired, see Rule 19.6 or 19.2.

AWARD SCHEDULE:

Perpetual Trophies maintained by ISRPA Highpower: Awarded to High Scorer regardless of residence: the Trophies are displayed at the ISPRPA Awards Banquet and on line on the ISRPA website www.isrpa.org. Trophies are updated annually after the conclusion of the State Championship Series and Awards are presented at the ISRPA Annual Awards Banquet in November. **A framed representation of each updated trophy is presented to each**

- Grand Aggregate (Across the Course, 300 Yard Reduced Course, and 100 Yard Reduced Course)

State Champion Award medallions are awarded to the State Champion (Highest scoring Indiana shooter), Class State Champion in each Class (5 or more shooters), and Junior State Champion. Awards are presented at the annual ISRPA Awards Banquet in November. (Awards mailed to those that cannot attend the Awards Presentation).

****Must be an Indiana Resident (or full time student in Indiana who does not participate in his or her home state championship to be eligible for State Champion awards.***
