FACILITIES: Lighted firing points with turning targets at 50 feet

ENTRIES LIMIT: Several Relays will be available at different locations, so it is important to reserve a spot on the relay you wish to shoot

NOTE: Preference for space availability will be given to "Shoot the Works" competitors. Each competitor will fire a complete "1800" before leaving the firing line.

TIME: Registration begins one half hour before relay start time each day. Please note: The matches will be conducted on local time.

RELAY 1: 9:00a.m. (local time)

---Muncie will shoot only 1 relay at 9am unless need for a Second Relay

RELAY 2: 11:30 a.m. (local time)

RELAY 3: 3:00p.m. (local time) This will only be used if 1&2 are full.

REGISTRATION FEE: \$5.50 NRA Fee

ENTRY FEE: \$5.00 per match plus registration fee or "Shoot the Works" for \$35.00, which includes the registration fee. *Junior shooters shoot for FREE!*

ENTRIES: Please Contact the range you wish to shoot at to set up time to shoot. Shooters may only Shoot Once for all matches. If you have any questions, please contact

RULES: Current NRA rules shall govern this match. Competitors will score another competitor's targets. During Center-fire Slow Fire, competitors will

change targets after every 5 shots. Entries in aggregate matches will close when the first match of the aggregate is fired. Challenge fee is \$2.00. If challenge is sustained, fee will be refunded. The plug-type scoring gauge will be restricted to use by the Executive Officer, Range Officers and the Referee.

TEAM MATCHES: ALL team matches will be NON-FIRED (paper) matches utilizing the NMC scores for each gun. The Indiana State Rifle and Pistol Association will sponsor no teams. Only NRA affiliated club teams are eligible to compete. Open teams are not eligible for team matches. No extra fees will be charged for team matches. No cash awards will be made for these matches.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Individuals who have not been classified will fire in the Master Class, Rule 19.6 (Assigned Classifications may be used.) Competitors will not be divided into categories. If there are less than 5 competitors in any other class, the class will be combined with the next higher class. A class will not be combined downward. If there are less than 5 High Masters, they will compete for MATCH WINNER only.
